RAGIN' CAJUN CRAWFISH BOIL RETURNS TO EAST DUNDEE FARMERS MARKET MAY 22

The popular crawfish boil returns to East Dundee's Depot, 319 N. River St., May 22 at 11a. Featured as part of the Sunday Farmers Market, held 9a-1p, the Ragin' Cajun Crawfish Boil features succulent crustaceans, along with corn and potatoes, prepared by Chef Cassandra of *Ruthella's New Orleans Cuisine*. **Zydeco Voodoo Band** will also be on hand to set the mood for this much anticipated; always fun event.

For those new to the delectable taste of crawfish, Chef Cass will explain how to prepare and eat them, right out of the shell. A hefty load of fresh, in-season crawfish will be delivered just for this event. Crawfish season typically begins in March and ends in July when hurricane season begins.

Chef Cass will be offering the traditional crawfish boil, including corn- on- the- cob and potatoes, for \$11 per person. The "boil" is a social affair that includes eating with your hands and enjoying the good company of others. Neatness is not required at this event, only a hearty appetite!

The Sunday Farmers Market, sponsored by the Village of East Dundee, is held on Sundays through the end of September. It features food and horticultural products sold by local farmers, producers and businesses. Vendors include: Klein's Farm and Garden Market; Waterfall Glen Soap Company; Butter and Flour; Katydid Crafts; Photography By Carol and Mt. Fuego Coffee Company, offering organic, free trade coffee. *Duke's BBQ* will also be at the market throughout the season and *Sharpening by Dave* will be onsite throughout the month of May.
