## MOTOR MONDAYS KICKS OFF EAST DUNDEE'S SIZZLIN' SUMMER EVENTS AT DEPOT JUNE 6

*Motor Mondays* revs into East Dundee June 6; 5pm –dusk; heralding the return of East Dundee's popular slate of weekly summer events at the Depot on River Street. *Motor Mondays* is a family-friendly event that showcases all varieties of cars, regardless of their make or model, along River Street, in the downtown East Dundee business district. Look for more hands-on and creative interactive opportunities – like games; crafts; pet adoption events and themed entertainment."

Visitors are also invited to enjoy the new walkways and landscaping that have recently been added to the area.

"We've been busy enhancing the grounds surrounding the Depot in order to provide a more inviting atmosphere for neighbors and visitors to enjoy our downtown business district," explained Village President, Lael Miller.
